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ICMS NOW INCORPORATES CDC EARLY WARNING SYMPTOM FEATURE

In response to recent world events and our clients needs, Wellsoft has introduced a timely new feature into the triage display of the *Integrated Clinical Management System*.

A field entitled 'CDC Early Warning Symptoms' has been incorporated. This field will allow the triage nurse to enter a number of presenting symptoms the patient may complain of via a pop-up menu into the Wellsoft system.

As with other triage fields, this field can be configured to be a required field. The grouping of symptoms was developed by a public health department and is supported by data from the CDC.

A report is available that will track these symptoms on a shift-by-shift basis. Every eight hours this report may be auto-faxed or e-mailed to the local health department. This feature will enable the health department to monitor for

epidemiological census spikes.

Wellsoft has been in close contact with the CDC and this is currently their preferred method of reporting. Wellsoft will continue to monitor the situation closely and make any necessary adjustments.

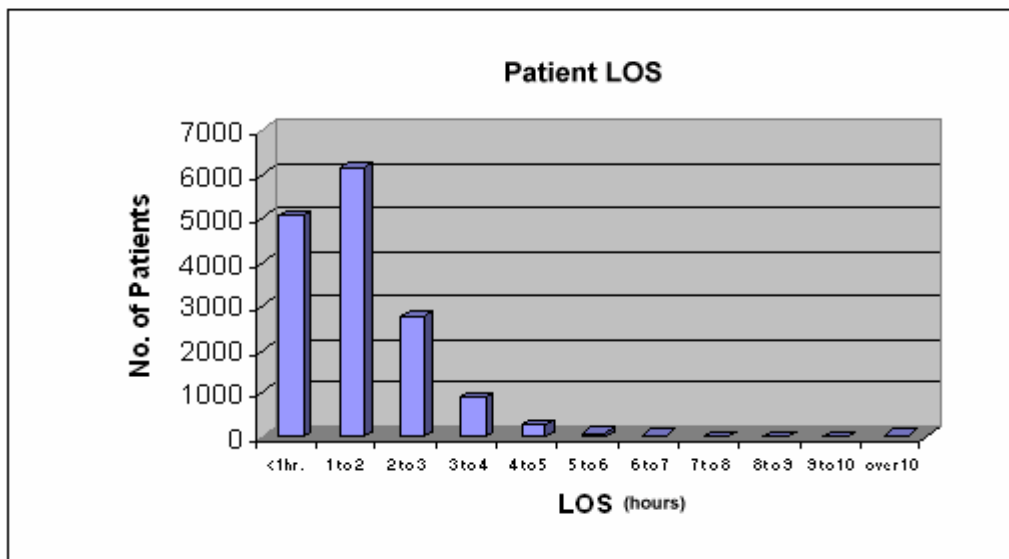
