PHYSICIAN ORDER ENTRY A SUCCESS ~ CARILION SYSTEM & MOORE REGIONAL

Wellssoft Corporation is pleased to announce the implementation of Computerized Physician Order Entry (CPOE) and Results Reporting at Moore Regional Hospital in Southern Pines, NC. Wellssoft is also happy to announce the implementation of CPOE at three Carilion Health System sites, Community, Memorial and New River Valley in the Roanoke, VA area.

Both Carilion and Moore place nursing, radiology, laboratory and EKG orders directly in the Wellssoft system. When results are returned, the tracking display is flagged and results are automatically sent to the patient's record. NEW ICMS FEATURES LIVE ~ MULTI DISCIPLINE DOCUMENTATION ~ INSTANT ACCESS KEY ~ CCOW

A new multi discipline documentation template is being used at North Oaks, Hammond, LA and at the Carilion System in Roanoke, VA. North Oaks is using this versatile template for psychiatric social worker documentation and Carilion is using the template for respiratory therapy. Wellsoft can configure this template for any hospital specific documentation need.

Wellsoft and Duke University Medical Center have implemented a new instant access key to provide the

Emergency Department with one touch access to their Clinical Reference Manual via Duke's intranet. This key can be used for immediate access to an intranet, Internet or another frequently used application, to name just a few possibilities.
